### Time for a weigh-in?


The practice has several new services to offer in 2016, including our new portable equine weighbridge. Getting an accurate weight for your horse is important, especially for dosing with wormers and other medications, or as part of a controlled weight-loss or weight-gain programme for conditions such as equine metabolic syndrome, laminitis, or following illness. The weighbridge is available for our clients to use at the clinic by appointment for just £5 per horse. Once you've booked a weigh-in, our nursing team will be on hand to help you. We can also book appointments to weigh horses at your yard, but a standard visit fee and £15 set-up charge will apply, so this is most efficient for larger groups of horses. # Worming Care Packages

We now have a simple and affordable way for all of our clients to get the best possible <u>independent</u> and <u>expert</u> advice about managing their horse's worming protocol. Our worming care package covers an entire year of worming advice and standard worm treatment for your horse including:

- 3 worm egg counts between March and November, with a text reminder service so you won't forget
- Equest® Pramox treatment (up to 700kg) for effective larvicidal and tapeworm treatment once during the winter period (December to February).
- Professional veterinary worming advice tailored to your individual needs, including an email follow-up of your own worming programme.

Have you got one last winter clip to do before the spring weather arrives and their summer coats come through? Paton and Lee offer a clipping service at the clinic. Simply book your appointment with the office in the usual way, and then you can drop your horse off at the clinic in the morning and collect him or her looking all fresh and squeaky clean later on the same day. No hairs up your nose, no fuss, and no need to have a call-out and sedation fee if your horse requires sedation, because we'll have a vet on hand to give sedation if it's required. ### **Behavioural consultations**

Following our fantastic day with Gemma Pearson from the University of Edinburgh back in October 2015, we have been developing an equine behavioural service at the practice. Chloe and Ben are heading up this service, but all of our vets have been getting more experience with using equitation science techniques. Ben is now a member of the International Society of Equitation Science, and having been honing their skills over the winter period, both Chloe and Ben are now in a position to offer equine behaviour consultations for the following conditions:

- Head-shy horses (difficult to bridle, worm or touch their ears, for example)
- Needle shy horses (do you dread the vet coming out for routine vaccinations?)
- Horses that require sedating for the farrier (how much does a set of shoes cost you?!?)
- Horses that resent other procedures such as treatment of their feathers, grooming, tacking up, touching the belly, having their tail touched etc.

As we gain more experience in this developing area we will be able to offer further-reaching behavioural consultations. Also, to continue building our experience, we are offering a fantastic **money-back guarantee** on all of our initial consultations for clients who are not completely satisfied with the outcome. Initial consultations cost £50 plus the standard visit fee. Follow up consultations, if required, are charged at our normal hourly rate.
