
Fridays, starting from Friday 11th November 2022, so if you're in this area you can book your half-price visit fee appointment with the office now!

New Strangles Vaccine Now Available

The strangles vaccination is administered just like the flu vaccine – into the muscle. The primary course is two doses given four weeks apart with 6 monthly boosters after this to maintain immunisation. Horses at high risk are recommended to have an additional booster 2 months after the primary course. The vaccine is designed to reduce the clinical symptoms of strangles (high temperature, coughing) and help decrease the incidence of lymph node abscesses. As a consequence, it also reduces the likelihood of complications and risk of infection spreading to other horses on the yard. StrangVac does not contain live bacteria and horses can still travel and compete when they have been given the vaccine since it does not interfere with any of the normal testing for strangles infection (PCR/blood samples etc.)

The price of these vaccines will be £60 per dose (price correct Nov 22) and can be booked on our half price 'zone days'. For more information please contact our reception.

Worm Care Packages – Now's the perfect time to join

If you haven't thought about joining our Worm Care Package before, now's the perfect time. Lots of our clients have signed up because it's such a simple, affordable way to get the best possible independent and expert advice about managing your horse's worming programme. Alternatively, we also offer a Worm Care Plus package which rather than the wormer, includes a blood sample to test for tapeworm and encysted red worm within your horse.

Therapeutic Laser



We are very pleased to be able to offer Class 4 therapeutic laser treatment for your horse for a range of different orthopaedic conditions.

Class 4 laser therapy is a safe non-invasive form of treatment that uses high doses of targeted near infrared laser energy. This has been known to provide pain relief, reduce inflammation and improve healing. Common musculoskeletal injuries that benefit from laser treatment include tendonitis, suspensory ligament injuries and back/ sacro-iliac problems. Class 4 laser is also able to stimulate wound healing and can be used in routine maintenance pre and post competition.

The treatment can be administered at your yard or at the practice and usually does not necessitate sedation. There is evidence based medicine supporting its use and it is a recognised form of treatment in most insurance claims.
